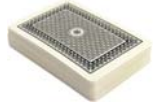

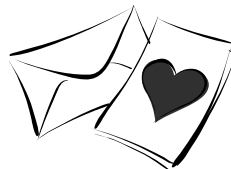
The "Rhoda Schreider Kitchen" sign will always remind me of the many meals and parties that were staged here. What a wonderful family you all are!
